MAJOR DISASTERS AND RESPONSES

(October 25-29, 1999)

SOMALI

Due to heavy rains that fell on the highlands of Hararghe in October 1999, the lowlying areas of Mustahil, Gode and the weredas of Western Immi in Gode Zone have been flooded. 7 oxen, 150 sheep and goats, 70 head of cattle and 40 camels have been killed by the floods. A team from the FDPPC has been sent to the affected areas to assess the extent of damage.

SPNNR

In Kucha Wereda of North Omo Zone, a landslide has caused damage to crops and property. Some people were also hurt.

OROMIA

The Zonal Technical Committee and the DPPD have reported that 9300 people in Meta Robi Wereda and 643 more in Welmerra Wereda of Western Shewa Zone need food assistance.
