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## MAJOR DISASTERS AND RESPONSES

(From September 12-15, 2000)

### AMHARA

In 2 localities in Dejen Wereda, East Gojjam Zone, there has been a landslide of 8-99% on 8.25 hectares of land covered with crops. However, the report doesn't say whether there has been damage to crops or property.

In 3 localities in Inemay Wereda of the same zone, a hailstorm has caused 10-97% damage to various kinds of crops on 254.735 hectares of land. This will affect 3,268 people. And in 2 localities in Baso Liben Wereda, 13 houses with corrugated roofs and 57 thatched houses were destroyed by a landslide.

Likewise, in Sekela Wereda of West Gojjam Zone, a hailstorm has caused limited damage to barley and maize crops in two localities.

And in some parts North Gondar zone, hailstorms are reported to have caused damage to crops and animals, but the extent of the damage is not known.

The rain in Yilmana Dinsa Wereda of West Gojjam Zone has not been sufficient for farming activities while crop growth has been hampered by too much rain in the highlands of North Wello Zone.

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### OROMIA

The low-lying weredas of Western Hararghe are affected by shortage of pasture and water due to the small amount of rain while crops are withering in the low-lying areas of Eastern Hararghe for the same reason. Shortage of rain also affects the low-lying areas of Arsi.
