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DPPC Fortnight Bulletin updates readers on what DPPC and its Partners are doing regarding Disaster Prevention and Preparedness and other related issues.

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MAJOR DISASTERS AND RESPONSES

(From February 7-11, 2000)

OROMIA

- The water shortage in Raitu and Sewina weredas of Bale Zone is worsening day by day. The DPPD has requested water tankering to be carried out especially in Raitu Wereda.
- Food is being distributed in Goro, Gura Damole, Medewelabo, Raitu, Beltu, Sewena and Ginir weredas. It has been requested that nutritional surveillance be conducted in the lowlying weredas of Raitu, Sewena, Biltu, Ginir, Goro and Medewebebo because of malnutrition which is affecting children.
- In Arsi Negele and Siraro weredas serious food shortages are being observed.
- In Ziway Dugda and Dodota Sire weredas, Arsi Zone, food shortages are becoming severe in localities which were identified for food assistance. Similarly, in the low-lying localities of Tiyo Wereda, food shortages are affecting an ever increasing number of people according to reports of the DPPD which also requested emergency food assistance to be sent to the area.
- In Mieso Wereda of Western Hararghe Zone, food is being distributed.
- Food shortages are being observed in Northern Shewa Zone where there has been crop failure due to erratic rains.

SNNPR

- In South Omo Zone, there is serious shortage of water and pasture while severe food shortages are affecting people in Selamago Wereda.

AMHARA

- In Kobo and Gubalafto weredas of North Wello Zone, cases of meningitis have been observed.
- There is no rain in all the weredas of North Wello, East Gojjam and Waghemra zones.
