# MAJOR DISASTERS AND RESPONSES

(From February 21-25, 2000)

## OROMIA

- The DPPD has reported that there is shortage of potable water in Ziway Dugda, Dodota Sire and Munesa weredas of Arsi Zone. Moreover, food shortages are being observed in the above mentioned weredas, including Tiyo. Therefore, there is a request for food assistance to be sent to the area.
- The shortage of pasture and water is becoming worse in Bale Zone. The problem is even more acute in Raitu, Sewina, Goro and Medewlabu weredas. Water tankering is being carried out in three localities in Beredemtu area in Raitu Wereda. Animals are also affected because of lack of water and pasture.
- In Arero, Yabelo, Teltele, Dire and Liben weredas of Borena Zone, animals are dying due to the serious shortage of water and pasture. Therefore, the number of people who need assistance is on the increase and those who were being monitored also need assistance.

## AMHARA

- 160 houses were burnt and property destroyed by fire on 15 February 2000 in Segno Gebeva, Lay Gayint Wereda, South Gondar Zone. 800-900 people who are affected by the fire are being helped.

## TIGRAY

- Because of the serious food shortages in Tenkua Abergelle, Kolla Temben, Were'ilehey, Dega Temben, Aditna'adir, Ahferom and Merab Lehey weredas of Central Zone, people are leaving the weredas in search of work.

- Similarly, people are moving out of Hawzen, Wukro and Atsbi Weredas of Eastern Zone.

## **SNNPR**

- The shortage of water and pasture is becoming worse in south Omo Zone. Humbo, Damot Weyde, Kindo Koysha areas in North Omo zone face the same problem.

## **SOMALI**

- Food is being distributed in Somali Region but still more food, especially supplementary food, is required.
- There is a serious water shortage in Danan, Gode Zone; in Gerbo, Dihun and segeg, Fik Zone; in Goro Bekoksa, Afder Zone and in Gashamo wereda of Degehabur Zone
