SNNPR

Food shortages continue to affect Selemago Wereda of South Omo Zone.

OROMIA

In Biltu Sewena, Raitu, Goro and Medewlebu weredas of Bale Zone, water and pasture are getting more scarce because of the severe drought. Especially in three localities of Raitu Wereda, in the areas called Beredimtu, Feti and Fincho, 5237 people and animals are in dire need of water. Some are reported to have left the areas in search of water.

The DPPD has requested emergency food assistance to be sent to Ziway Dugda, Dodota Sire and Tiyo weredas of Arsi Zone because of the worsening food shortages.
