MAJOR DISASTERS AND RESPONSES

(From April 24-28, 2000)

SOMALI

In Degehabur Wereda of Degehabur Zone, children are seriously affected by malnutrition and animals are dying in large numbers.

In Kebridechar Wereda of Korahe Zone, animals are severely affected by the absence of rain, and water is being tankered by 3 trucks provided by SERP, AICF and the region's DPPB. Diseases like dysentery, TB, malaria and measles are being observed but there are no medicines to control them.

OROMIA

309 homes worth 247,000 Birr were destroyed and 1,500 households made homeless by hailstorm on 20 April 2000 in Bube town in Nole Kaba, Western Wellega Zone.

Emergency food is being distributed in 10 weredas in Borena Zone by CARE, EECMY and COOPI.

The DPPD of Arsi Zone has requested food to be sent to Merti, Golecha, Chole, Jeju, Munnesa, Sudena and Seru weredas which are affected by increasingly serious food shortages.
