MAJOR DISASTERS AND RESPONSES

(From June 26-30, 2000)

AMHARA

In Goncha-Siso Inese Wereda of East Gojjam Zone, due to the shortage of rain last year, long cycle crops were not sown and crop yield was generally low especially in the low-lying area causing serious food shortages this year. As a result, 111 heads of households from localities in the Abbay River valley have left the area in search of work, students have stopped going to school, infants are showing signs of malnutrition, animals are weak and their prices are low on the market.

In Ziquala Wereda, Waghembra Zone, the condition of animals is bad because of lack of pasture which resulted also in students not attending school and farmers not fully working the land as they have to move from place to place looking for pasture.

There is shortage of rain in all the weredas of South Wello Zone. Although it drizzled at the beginning of the week, the crops continued to wither as there had been no rain before.

Similarly, there is scarcity of rain in Farta, Libo Kemkem, Iste, Simada, Lay Gayint and Tach Gayint mid-highland and highland weredas in South Gondar Zone. However, sowing is underway while in the low-lying areas sowing has not yet been started because there is no rain at all.

HARARI

In Harari area there has been an outbreak of black leg and animals are being vaccinated.

There has been no rain in the region and there is general shortage of water.
