Food Aid Distributed in Somali and Oromia Regions

Food aid has been distributed to 1,394,000 drought victims in Jijiga zone, Somali region and East Hararge zone, Oromia region since February 2001.

Food aid distributed, including supplementary food, during February-May 2001 amounts to 1,355,870.40 quintals most of which was distributed by NGOs, it was disclosed by concerned authorities of the regions. Most of the beneficiaries in Oromia took part in Employment Generation Schemes (EGS) whereby the able bodied got food in return for work while a few who were unable to take part in the programme received free supplies of food.

Those who were engaged in EGS were contributing their part in various development endeavors such as road maintenance, spring water development, soil and water conservation, construction of additional rooms for some schools and others which are used to serve the community.

Donation to assist drought victims obtained

Ground Forces regular civil servants donated Birr 4430.66 (four thousand four hundred thirty Birr and sixty-six cents) to help drought victims. The donation was a contribution of 5% of their July and August 2000 salaries. The money was submitted to the DPPC on June 25, 2001 by their representatives, Ato Biru Beshir, Head of civil personnel of Ground Force Engineering Department and W/ro Mieraß Mehari, Member of Ground Forces Engineering Department Finance Division.

Major Disasters and Responses

(From June 8-15, 2001)

Amhara

Symptoms of malnutrition have been observed on children and old people in Goncha Siso Woreda of East Gojam. Besides, 517 persons are reported to have left their localities with their families in search of work.

Disease that affects sheep and goats, locally known as "Yeda", is reported from Zikuála and Sekota Woredas of Waghemra Zone. It has not been possible to bring the disease under control because of shortage of medicine.

Oromia

In Guracha locality of Sinana and Dinsho weredas, Bale zone, 16 persons were sick with dysentery and are receiving treatment. In a similar development, 100,000 people have been vaccinated against meningitis in Chelia, Ambo and Ejere weredas of West Shoa while 200 persons affected by dysentery are receiving medical treatment in Chelia Wereda.

Hailstorm damaged crops in Darò Labu Wereda of East Hararghe zone the extent of which is being assessed. Similarly, 16 residential houses in Bulbula peasant association in Adami Tulu of East Shoa were damaged out of which 6 houses were rendered useless and 10 were partially damaged due to heavy rain, it was reported.

In a different development, measures against outbreak of anthrax are being taken in Meiso Wereda of East Hararghe zone and Ambo as well as Bako Tibe weredas of West Shoa zone.
