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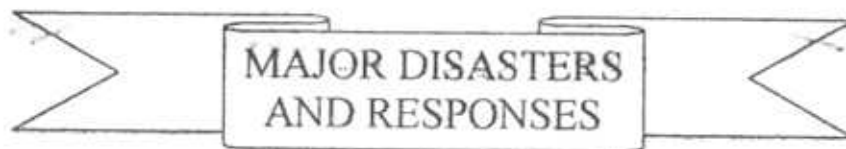

Food Aid Allocation or Distribution Disclosed

Food aid which was allocated for October 2001 for distribution was 31,033.46 MT, it was disclosed. Out of this allocation which is assumed to have been distributed 11,419.58 MT was by the DPPC while 19,613.88 MT was done by NGOs.

The total amount distributed since January 2001 has reached 552,625.61 MT. (Please refer to details on next page).

Oromia

From the low-lying weredas of Dire, Moyale and Teltele, Borena Zone, there are reports of food shortages by the Wereda Disaster Prevention and Preparedness Committees. On the other hand, according to the information we obtained from Oromia Disaster Prevention and Preparedness Bureau, Care has transported food aid to Dirre, Yabelo and Teltele weredas during September and October. SCF-UK has also been transporting unidentified amount of aid to the same areas.

Amhara

There has been no rain in Tach Gaynt and Lay Gaynt weredas of South Gondar Zone. The low-lying areas are especially affected as it ceased to rain in August as a result crops have been damaged.
